Information sheet (B.P.Ed) for Re-admission 2025-27

General Information:

Nikhil Banga Sikshan Mahavidyalaya is situated at **Bishnupur** in the district of Bankura and was established in the year **1969.** The college is located at Bishnupur Town under Bishnupur Municipality. The infrastructure of the college is at 'state of the art' with computers, internet, enriched Library with around 21000 books and regular subscriber of reputed Journals. The Institute has introduced B.P.Ed curriculum from the year 1978. From 2024, The Institution allowed **FEMALE** candidates for admission to B.P.Ed course.

Re-admission Procedure

Admission shall be made on merit on the basis of marks obtained in the previous examination and Fitness test. Detail distribution of marks will be notified in the website

Admission Information: 2025-27 (Both Male & Female)

- 1. Successful submission of application form through online, for admission to B P. Ed Course 2025-27, to this college does not automatically ensure his/her eligibility for admission to the course.
- 2. Online application procedure would start from 11.00 am of 13.10.2025 and will be open up to 6.00 pm of 29.10.2025.
- 3. Course Offered: Bachelor of Physical Education (B.P.Ed.): Two- Year Duration under Semester System.

Eligibility:

a. Bachelor's Degree in any discipline with 50% marks and having at least participation in the Inter- College/ Inter- Zonal/ District/ School competition in sports and games as recognized by the AIU/IOA/SGFI/Govt. of India.

OR

- b. Bachelor's Degree in Physical Education with 45% marks.

 OR
- c. Bachelor's Degree in any discipline with 45% marks and studied Physical Education as compulsory elective subject with **300 marks**.

OR

d. Bachelor's Degree with 45% marks and having participated in National/Inter University/State Competitions or secured 1st, 2nd or 3rd position in Inter- College/ Inter- Zonal/District/

School competition in sports and games as recognized by the AIU/IOA/SGFI/Govt. of India

OR

e. Bachelor's Degree with participation in International Competitions or secured 1st, 2nd or 3rd position in National/Inter University competition in sports and games as recognized by respective federations/ AIU/IOA/SGFI/Govt. of India.

OR

- f. Graduate with 45% marks and at least three years of teaching experience (for deputed inservice candidates i.e. trained physical education teachers/ coaches)
- 4. However, 5% marks relaxation will be given to SC/ST/PWD candidates.
- 5. Age of Fresher candidate as on 30th August, 2025, would be less than 38 years (relaxation as per Govt. of West Bengal).
- 6. All the terms and conditions must be read carefully before going to fill up the online form and only when the same is acceptable, complete the process of filling up.
- 7. First, register yourself with the help of your e-mail Id and Mobile Number. These two are very important, because frequent message etc. may be communicated through the same.
- 8. Fill up the form electronically as per cues/directions generated while proceeding step by step.
- 9. After entering general information and academic qualification, the candidate has to accept the terms and conditions by a 'click' at the appropriate space.
- 10. Provisional eligible list will be published on the college website: www.nbsmahavidyalaya.ac.in only. Tentative date of publication of Eligible List is 01.11.2025 and date for Physical Fitness Test is 06.11.25.
- 11. After the publication of Eligible list based on NCTE norm, the candidates have to appear the field test comprising of Physical Fitness Test and Sports Proficiency Test (Written test). Final Merit list will be prepared on the basis of marks obtained through academic records and field test and will be published on **07.11.25** on the college website: www.nbsmahavidyalaya.ac.in only.
- 12. Date of admission is **08.11.25 & 10.11.25.**
- 13. **Verification of all original documents** will be made on the day of Physical Fitness Test by the admission committee.
- 14. **Reservation:** @ 22%, 10%, 7%, 6% and 3% of total seats will be reserved for SC, OBC A, OBC B, ST and PWD candidates respectively.

15. Calculation of academic norms:

o 10% of the percentage of obtained marks in Madhyamik/equivalent examination.

- o 10% of percentage of obtained marks in H.S./equivalent examination.
- 15% of percentage of obtained marks in Degree General level examination (in case of candidates with only General level degree).
- Sports achievement: International level 10 point, National level 8, Inter University level 6, State Level 4, District level (Inter College/School) 2. Highest participation to be considered.

ATTENTION

The total obtain marks at the UG level examination (Pass &Hons.) will be calculated in the following way -

For Hon's Candidate: Aggregate (Total) Marks = Hon's Subject Total Marks + Pass Subject Total Marks (Excluding Compulsory Language and Compulsory Elective subjects Marks) and same procedure for calculation of Total Marks Obtained. For Pass Candidate: Aggregate (Total) Marks = Pass Subject Total Marks (Excluding Compulsory Language and Compulsory Elective subjects Marks) and same procedure for calculation of Total Marks Obtained.

- 16. Rules of the **Burdwan University**, the Govt. of West Bengal & the NCTE will be followed.
- 17. **20%** seats of the candidates will be reserved for the other university candidates. Last Degree will be considered for determining candidature of a particular category.
- 18. In case of any dispute, the decision of the Admission Committee of the college is final.
