Report on School Internship (B.Ed SEM II) for B.Ed students of session 2023- 25

Introduction:

Over the past few years, the B.Ed. program has changed significantly throughout India. Transitioning from a one-year program to a two-year B.Ed. program is an exciting and challenging undertaking.
