Report of Vidyasagar Jayanti celebrated on 26.9.24

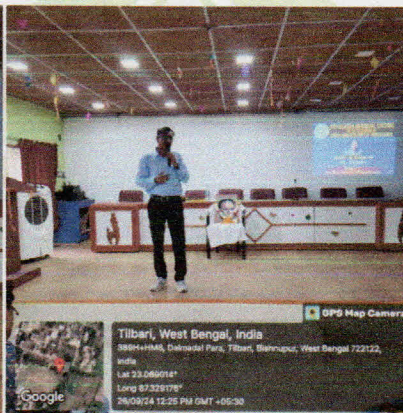
Ishwar Chandra Vidyasagar was a man who had a significant impact on his community. He was highly intelligent, and he used his abilities and expertise to benefit the country. To disrupt the social order, he defied Indian custom. He wasn't worried about the response he received at the time. On September 26, 1820, he was born into a Hindu Brahmin family in the Bengal Presidency of British India. IQAC, Nikhil Banga Sikshan Mahavidyalayahad organized a discussion session on Pandit Iswar Chandra Vidyasagar to honor the Great Scholar, Social and Academic Reformer of Bengal following the schedule:
