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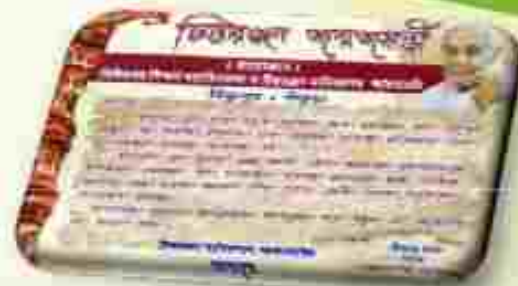

The Rajiv Gandhi National Institute of Youth Development, Sriperumbudur, introduced life skills as a subject of study in India in 2008, and a program for training life skills instructors was then initiated. A variety of psycho-social and cognitive skills can be considered life skills, as they enable youngsters to regulate their emotional health, communicate well, and make well-informed decisions. classes for add on course were delivered by following the specific Time table. In the orientation programme students were informed about the add on course by the Principal and other resource persons. Principal informed that minimum 75% attendance is essential to complete the course. Total 97 students participated in the programme and only 55 students qualified for final



evaluation. Finally 48 students sit on examination. Life skill education has been shown to be a successful psychosocial intervention strategy for fostering adolescents' positive social and mental health. It is important in all aspects, including boosting emotional intelligence, coping skills, and self-confidence, as well as improving critical thinking, problem solving, and decision making abilities.
