The MOU in view of exploring the possibilities between the parties in terms of Faculty /Student /Staff exchange programme for mutual benefit of both the institutions. The MOU is effective from. 28.11.2023 to establish an affiliation by and between Ramananda College & Nikhil Banga Sikshan Mahavidyalaya. Having an expertise in the area of inter exchanging lectures delivered having its office at Ramananda College, the First party.

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Nikhil Banga Sikshan Mahavidyalaya, under Baba Saheb Ambedkar University having its office located at Tilbari, Bishnupur, Bankura here in after referred to as NBSM, of the second party, for the purpose of exchange of faculty for academic purpose. The said institution is here in after referred to individually as Institute and collectively as Institutes.

2. BACK GROUND OF MOU: Whereas, the UGC (Promotion and Maintenance of Standards of Academic Collaboration between two Colleges) Regulations, 2016, mandate framing of collaboration policy of the UGC consistency hereto.

Where As, the inter exchanging of higher education is providing an ever growing range of opportunities for encouragement with universities and Colleges in the nearer Colleges.

Whereas, to create a strong and viable teaching system for the well being of the students as envisaged under the Policy of NAAC.

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- 3. GENERAL: Ramananda College and Nikhil Banga Sikshan Mahavidyalaya have teachers in different subjects such as English, History, Education, Physical Education, Bengali etc. Now Therefore, Ramananda College and Nikhil Banga Sikshan Mahavidyalaya have decided to enter into this MOU which defines the framework for the cooperation of the Two Colleges set out in the following sections.
- 4. PROPOSED OBJECTIVES AND EXPECTED OUTCOMES: In consideration of the mutual promises set forth in this MOU, both Colleges are agree to the following collaborative activities in the academic areas of mutual interest, on a basis of equality and reciprocity. The objectives of the MOU are as follows.

Terms and conditions for each visit or an assignment or such exchange, including those concerning Travelling Allowance and any other matter related to it will be worked out between the Two Colleges on the mutual basis. A separate agreement will be entered into giving such details including term of exchange of any intellectual
