Report of ORAL PRESENTATION Competition for B.Ed SEM I students  
of session 2025-27

**Introduction:**

Nikhil Banga Sikshan Mahavidyalaya is a co-educational Teacher Training Institute offering B.Ed. and B.P.Ed. programmes, duly recognized by NCTE. Established in 1969, the institution is situated in Bishnupur town of Bankura district, a place renowned for its rich cultural heritage, particularly in art and architecture.

As a part of the practicum of Course-IV, an **Oral Presentation Competition** was successfully organized by the B.Ed. Department of the college under the guidance and supervision of Sri Arabinda Dey. The programme aimed at developing effective communication skills, enhancing confidence, and improving the presentation abilities of the trainee teachers.



**Execution and Evaluation:**

The students of Semester-I (Session: 2025-2027) delivered their oral presentations along with PowerPoint presentations over a period from 19.01.2026 to 05.03.2026. The presentations were evaluated by the Teacher Educators of the college on the basis of specific components, namely: **introduction, relevance, presentation, voice, conclusion, and interaction**. Each component carried **10 marks**, making a total of **60 marks (10 × 6)** for the purpose of assessment and evaluation.

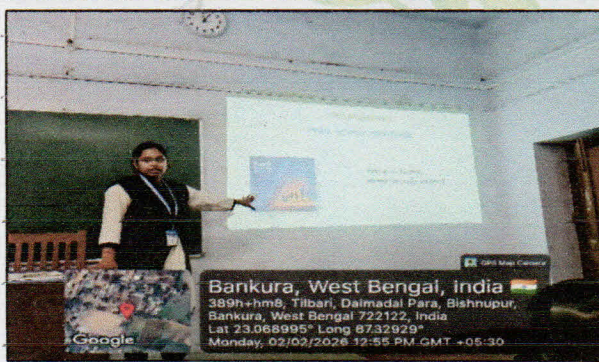
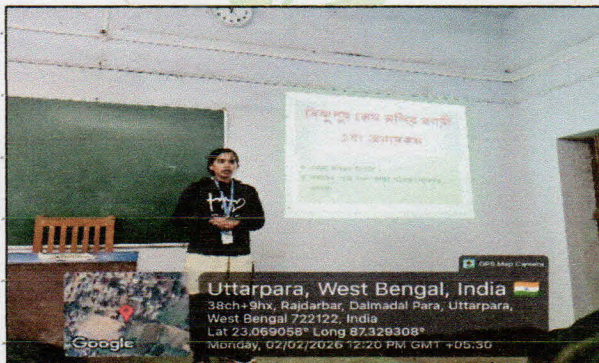
The results were published based on the total marks obtained out of 60. Students securing the best positions were selected for rewards on the basis of their overall presentation skills. Both the **PowerPoint presentations and oral delivery** were carefully observed by the judges, and **spot evaluation** was conducted accordingly.

The time allotted for each presentation was limited to **10 minutes**. The presentations, including PowerPoint slides, were prepared in both **Bengali and English** to ensure better understanding. The medium of instruction was confined to these two languages only.

Students were also encouraged to engage in **interactive communication** during the presentations, which made the sessions more effective, participatory, and academically enriching.

**Result:** Based on the above evaluation criteria, the following results were obtained:
