Report on Field Survey to Ajodhya Pahar of West Bengal on 10.07.2026

Introduction: An educational field trip to Ajodhya Hills in the Purulia district of West Bengal was arranged as part of the B.Ed. program. The purpose of the excursion was to provide student-teachers a firsthand look at the physical topography, biodiversity, tribal culture, environmental preservation, and sustainable tourism practices of the area. The Ajodhya Hills are renowned for their natural beauty, waterfalls, forests, and rich cultural legacy. They are a part of the Dalma Hills and the eastern extension of the Eastern Ghats.

Objectives: (i) To study the physical features of the Ajodhya Hills, (ii) To observe the flora and fauna of the region, (iii) To understand the lifestyle and culture of the indigenous tribal communities, (iv) To promote environmental awareness and responsible tourism, (v) To provide experiential learning opportunities for student-teachers.

Execution : The participants visited a number of significant sites, such as the Upper and Lower Dams, Pakhi Pahar (Bird Hill), Turga Dam and Falls, and Bamni Falls. The natural environment, rock formations, forest ecosystem, and water conservation structures were all observed by the students. Along with learning about Chhau mask-making, traditional handicrafts, and the region's cultural significance, they also engaged with locals.



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
